Unloading will be by means of large double doors straight into the exhibition hall. 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## the venue

Chilford Hall has an excellent purpose-built exhibition space and other halls which are ideal for the fair. It is well signposted from major routes such as the M11 and A14 and will also benefit from AA signing on the day.

## stands

The fair can accommodate approximately 100 tables in the Pavilion Hall (dependent on configuration) and 30 tables in the Contemporary Hall. Each table measures 6ft x 2ft 6ins. Chairs will be provided. Whilst we will endeavour to maintain stand positions this cannot be guaranteed.

Exhibitors must provide their own table coverings, which should extend to the floor at both the front and sides. Power is available to all tables for lighting purposes *only*. Exhibitors should ensure that their extension cables and lights are electrically safe and tested regularly.

**No tables can be used other than those provided except for a small table behind your stand to work from, so long as you do not impinge on your neighbours' space or access. Please advise us of this in advance.**

If you wish to use floor standing display cases then you must discuss this with us before booking. **Tables must be left in their original position.** Please check your tables before use.

Only two entry badges will be issued per stand unless by prior arrangement. Your badges and table numbers will be left on your table for you when you arrive. **Please wear your badges at all times in order that we may identify visitors who try to gain early entry to the fair. Your co-operation in this matter would be appreciated.**

**Please be aware that stands cannot be shared with, or assistance given by, other non-participating dealers/collectors without written permission of from Specialist Glass Fairs.**

All items will be assumed to be in perfect condition unless clearly marked as at fault (A/F). Receipts must be given if requested. Please do not offer for sale items that have been heavily restored.

## dateline

There will be no dateline at this fair as we are keen to promote contemporary glass. This is a high quality glass fair and the organisers reserve the right to prohibit low quality stock.

## advertising

The fair will be advertised widely in all the usual magazines and specialist publications as well as in the local press. It will also be promoted on the internet, local radio and via the website. Postcards and posters will be distributed in the preceding months to both the public and exhibitors. In addition, we have an extensive mailing list of local people interested in decorative arts. A poster campaign will be undertaken in Cambridge and the surrounding area.
